

# Antique Tractor Pull

**All participants must have a booster button or day pass to enter fairgrounds**

## **General Rules:**

1. All participants are encouraged to help keep this a family-friendly and enjoyable event.
2. Open to tractors 1960 and older.
3. Pullers must be a minimum of 12 years old at the time of the pull.
4. All pullers must sign a waiver at registration. Pullers 12 to 16 years old must have a parent or guardian sign and be present during the pull.
5. Any tractor with its engine running must have an operator in the seat at all times.
6. All tractors must have working brakes and an operational governor.
7. Suitcase weights will be allowed with a limit of 1000 pounds.
8. No weight can be bolted in the driver area.
9. Each tractor may enter 2 classes.
10. Any tractor leaking excessive fluids will be grounds for disqualification at the discretion of the committee.
11. All tractors will be in stock condition as they came from the factory, with no pulling enhancements or modifications.
12. No racing or aviation gasoline or octane booster permitted.
13. Tractors will pull from original factory drawbar, stationary in all directions and parallel with the ground. 17" max. height and 22" min. length from the center of the axle for 6500 lb. class and under. 20" max. height and 25" min. length for 7000 lb. class and over.
14. No electric fans or electric fuel pumps.
15. No cut tires, chains, radials, or duals.
16. Factory clevis or shackle may be used, straight or twisted type, with a minimum of 2 ½" hole, bolted or pinned tightly with spacer to drawbar. Pull plate material is allowed; material cannot be thinner than ¾" and not thicker than 1 ¼". Plate must have a 2 ½" hole with 1" material thickness around the hole. The drawbar must remain inside the opening of the clevis. Any tractor pulling from a non-fixed drawbar (i.e. draft control, three point hitch, or two point hitch) must secure the hitch in the locked position. All tractors without stationary hitches will pull exhibition only. Top of hitch adjuster cannot be above the center line of axle except for factory mounts. No top link to center of drawbar.
17. All tractors will be checked by the committee. All decisions of the committee and track officials are final.
18. Driver must remain seated. Track officials will stop the pull at any time they feel the tractor or driver is unsafe.
19. No shifting of gears during the pull, including torque amplifiers.
20. Committee will determine if the driver is capable. Driver cannot be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
21. Driver must weigh-in tractor and may be subject to re-weighing after pulling.
22. Only parts from the parts book for that model of tractor are allowed. Seats must be stock or a replace-



ment seat with stock mountings. Replacement alternators or straight exhaust pipes are allowed. Stock side shields allowed if factory equipped. Tractor and wheel weights will not exceed 8' 6" in width.

- 23. All tractors that show up may pull exhibition.
- 24. A 3.5 MPH speed limit will be enforced. One warning horn will be given, a second horn will make the pull exhibition.
- 25. No riders allowed on tractors at any time.
- 26. Maximum speed for all tractors while on the fairgrounds is 5 mph.
- 27. No rain make-up date.
- 28. Rules subject to change.
